This is the last Will and Testament of me James Mc Soriley of Woodend in Victoria Farmer After payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I devise and bequeath all the property both real and personal whatsoever and where so ever of which I shall die possessed to my daughters Alice Mc Soriley and Jane Mc Soriley their heirs executors administrators and assigns Upon Trust to permit and allow my wife Catherine Mc Soriley to occupy the same and receive the rents and profits thereof during her life And after her death Upon Trust for my daughter Catherine Mc Soriley her heirs executors administrators and assigns absolutely And I appoint my said daughters Alice Mc Soriley and Jane Mc Soriley or the survivor of them executrices or executors of this my will In witness whereof I the said James Mc Soriley the testator have to this my last will and testament set and subscribed my hand this fifth day of August 1906.
